### **Introduction to Forestry:**

Topics to be covered include Tree ID, Property Tax Laws, Boundary Marking, Road and Trail Construction, Vine Control, Habitat Management, Management Plans, etc...

### **Timber Stand Improvement:**

Topics include making thinning decisions in the woodland, vine control, invasive species control, chainsaw safety and directional felling techniques.

**Timber Marketing:** Topics include IF, WHEN, and HOW to sell timber. This session includes 2 to 3 hours indoors and the afternoon selecting trees to harvest.
