  - Documents institutional approval for submission of the application and of the proposed research;
  - Describes the particular arrangements at the 1890 LGU regarding salary, date, and duration of the fellowship leave; and
  - Recognizes the full-time nature of the fellowship leave, including agreement that the 1890 LGU faculty member will be conducting the research at the ARS location and thus will be minimally engaged in their normal faculty duties.

Applicants may also provide a works cited list and supplemental tables and figures, as applicable.

The ARS scientist/host mentor shall submit the completed application package within ARS in accordance with the submission instructions found in the 1890 FRSP FY 2020 Program Information document.
