



Figure 1. Box and whisker plot of rank for mean area under the disease progress curve of 21 clones evaluated at five locations in the 2006 National Late Blight Trials. For each clone, the box represents the interquartile range (the range from 25% to 75% of the rankings), the black line inside the boxes represents the median, and the fine horizontal lines (the ends of the 'whiskers') represent the minimum and maximum values excluding outliers and extreme values. Open circles designate outliers (values that are 1.5-3.0 box lengths from the upper or lower edge of the box) and extreme values (>3.0 box lengths from the upper or lower edge of the box).
