Listed below are some of the significant environmental aspects, objectives, and targets for 2009, and the target dates of completion.

1. Significant Environmental Aspect: Employee Awareness of EMS  
Objective: Educate employees about EMS  
Target: Inform all employees of appropriate AgLearn EMS Awareness Training modules  
Anticipated Completion Date: April 17, 2009
  
2. Significant Environmental Aspect: Hazardous Chemical Purchases and Tracking  
Objective: Utilize CATS to track hazardous chemical purchases, and use CIS for inventory  
Target: (1) Inform all purchasers of prudent hazardous chemical purchase practices, and to consider sharing chemicals whenever possible, to reduce purchase load, (2) Reduce annual chemical purchases by 20% before 2011  
Anticipated Completion Date: (1) April 17, 2009 (2) April 2011
  
3. Significant Environmental Aspect: Building Heating & Cooling Costs at WHNRC  
Objective: Monitor systems usage times and amounts to get an idea of repetitive patterns  
Target: Reduce usage by 5% after one year, and an additional 5% the second year  
Anticipated Completion Date: April 2010, & April 2011
  
4. Significant Environmental Aspect: Steam usage at Armstrong Greenhouses  
Objective: Eliminate unnecessary steam use by modernizing the steam generation equipment, and by setting up a control and metering system  
Target: Reduce steam usage by 15% after one year, and an additional 5% the second year  
Anticipated Completion Date: April 2010, & April 2011
