There were 210 attendees representing growers, industry, and government. Presentations provided information on subject areas ranging from genetics and breeding to marketing. The issues surrounding public lands were discussed as they applied to lamb production, both present and the future. Dr. Melinda Ellison, a new hire and animal nutritionist at the University of Idaho, Nancy M. Cummings Research and Extension and Education Center, Salmon ID, was introduced. She will endeavor to assist in research with the USDA at the Dubois, ID Animal Research Center in the area of grazing and nutrition of sheep. The FRRL's improved plant materials will be evaluated to determine what enhancements in animal productivity accuses from grazing under novel management regimes. FRRL plant materials were exhibited and questions were answered regarding rangeland sheep management and how these improved plant materials could enhance productivity.
