



MEDITERRANEAN FLOUR MOTH
 (*Anagasta kuhniella* (ZELL.))

MOTH HAS A WING-SPREAD OF SLIGHTLY LESS THAN 1 INCH. FOREWINGS ARE A PALE LEADEN GRAY WITH TRANSVERSE WAVY BLACK MARKINGS. HIND WINGS ARE A DIRTY WHITE. MOTH IS A NATIVE OF EUROPE. IT WAS FIRST DISCOVERED IN U.S. IN 1892 IN CALIFORNIA. LARVAE IS DESTRUCTIVE STAGE.
