"Arbed," NPARL's resident mad scientist, brews up a tasty treat for visitors attending the Business After Hours event held at the lab October 22, 2002.





"The Flea", TEAM Leafy Spurge 's successful biocontrol beetle, gets the star treatment in this poster.




