

How do cows make milk?

Cows eat feeds which contain many nutrients: carbohydrates fats protein water



- The feed is broken down and the nutrients are mixed up and moved through her four stomach compartments: rumen, reticulum, omasum, and abomasum.
- The digested feed moves to her small intestine . . .

... where the nutrients are absorbed into the bloodstream and carried to the udder ...

4 ... where the cow puts the nutrients into another form to make milk.



Absorbed nutrients are also used to nourish the cow.

Undigested feed passes out as waste (manure).
