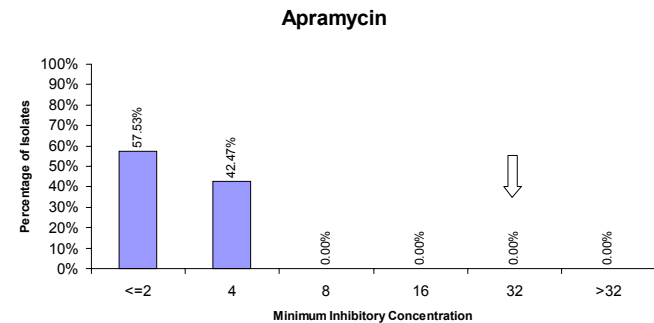

Fig. 9. Minimum Inhibitory Concentrations by Antimicrobial Agent for All Salmonella Isolates from Exotic Sources



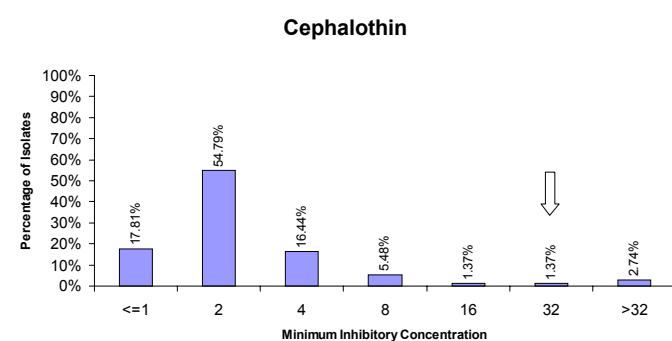
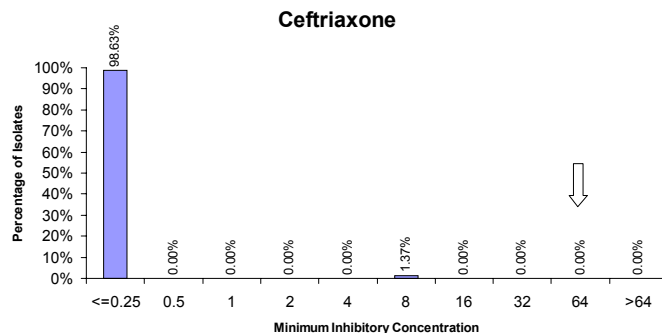
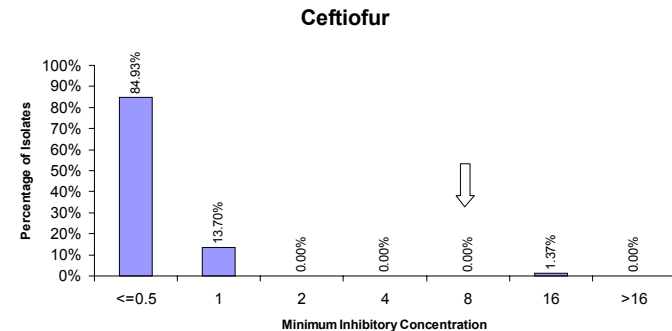
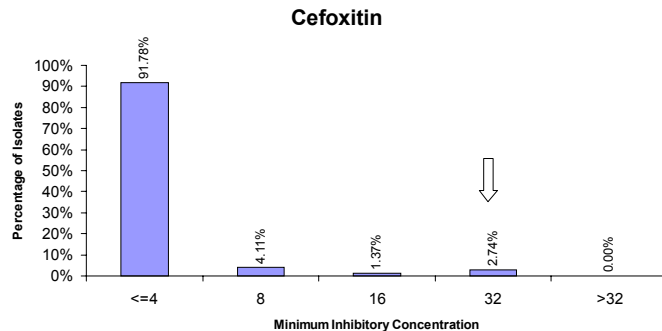
