Universal waste regulations streamline collection requirements for certain hazardous wastes into the following categories:

- Batteries
- Pesticides
- Mercury-Containing Thermostats
- Lamps

The items listed above should never be put into the trash, but should be collected until a pickup is scheduled.

Georgia Clean Day

- This program, organized at least annually by the Georgia Department of Agriculture, gives everyone an opportunity to discard old, unusable, or cancelled pesticides at no charge. We encourage everyone to take advantage of this great program when it is available.
