In addition to being involved in evaluating the science within projects, he is responsible for coordination of certain activities in the Unit and in management aspects such as proposal evaluation and selection, negotiation of work to be carried out, and supervision of projects, as well as in the follow up of scientific developments in his area of responsibility.
